

Library of Birmingham Wi-Fi

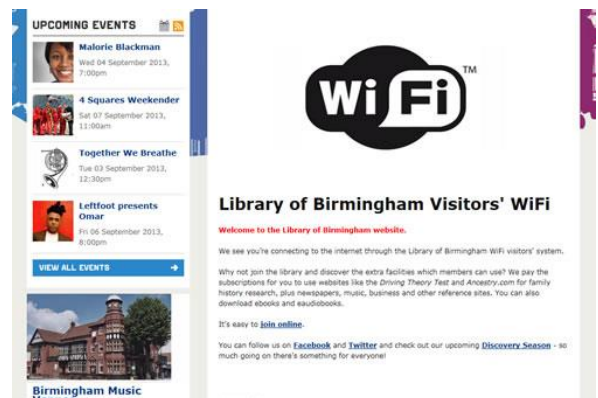
Free Wi-Fi connectivity is available throughout the Library of Birmingham for use with laptops and portable devices.

Access extends onto the terraces & outside spaces.

To access Wi-Fi use **Visitors_Library_of_Birmingham**

Visitors_Library_of_Birmingham

- Anyone visiting the Library of Birmingham can connect to this network from their phone, tablet, laptop etc. for free.
- When you first select this option you will be taken to a login screen with a button asking if you want to **Get Online**.
- The next screen asks for a first and last name and email address. Once all these details have been submitted the **LoB Visitors** Wi-Fi page displays.
- **This is the only time you will need to do this.** You may be asked to sign onto the network again but all that happens is that you will then be redirected to the LoB Wi-Fi page.
- The visitor Wi-Fi network will not allow you to access the LoB subscription sites.
- If your access times-out then just log back in.



When you have logged into the Wi-Fi once then on subsequent visits the device used should remember the settings and log you in automatically.

We are exploring Wi-Fi printing from your laptop and this should be available mid-2014. At the moment to print from your laptop, tablet etc you will need to email your content to yourself and then log on to one of the Public PCs to print it.

If you decide to use LoB Wi-Fi you are agreeing to the terms and conditions. These are displayed in full at log in.
